PURPOSE OF THE JOB

Under the supervision of the Lead Lift Mechanic, Lift Mechanic Supervisor or Director of Operations, this position is responsible for carrying out regular maintenance, inspections, and routine repairs on the resorts ski lifts. It is the responsibility of the whole department to identify any situations related to the safe and proper operation of the lifts and to bring these to the attention of their Supervisor or Director of Operations. A Lift Mechanic will be a team player working closely with Lift Maintenance and other departments such as Lift Operations. This position requires a self-starter with a strong work ethic to help achieve a high standard of safety and reliability.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform scheduled maintenance, inspections, and repairs on the resorts lift system recording information to work orders, inspections forms or summer maintenance forms completing in an efficient and timely manner
- □ Identify mechanical problems, replace / repair parts on lifts or carpets
- □ Maintain a high level of safety on the job, and for other staff and guests
- □ Contribute to the long-term reliability of the lifts and their components
- Promote effective communication between Lift Maintenance and other departments

PHYSICAL & TIME REQUIREMENTS

- □ Day Shift Hours 0730 1700
- □ Night Shift Hours 1530 0000

- □ Able and willing to climb lift towers and work above ground in stations (Ability to ascend/descend a ladder and comfortable working from heights)
- □ Ability to push/pull
- D Physically fit to shovel snow
- □ Lift up to 40 lbs, assisted lifts with anything over 40 lbs
- □ Ability to remain stationary for long periods of time outside
- □ Stability to walk on uneven surfaces and icy conditions
