Under the direction of Ski Patrol Director, Resort General Manager and Operations manager

Document and assign duties for medical emergencies, snow safety, avalanche rescue, and evacuations. Coordinate and communicate mountain status with mountain operations, employees, other departments, and guests.

### Position Functions / Areas of Responsibility

- 1. Assign, dispatch, and record emergency and non- emergency events for resort operations
- 2. Communicate and record mountain information
- 3. Dispatch customer service
- 4. Verify and maintain appropriate personnel
- 5. Transmits or receives information between departments
- 6. Obtains the nature, location, and information involved with emergencies.
- 7. Create Announcements for Patrol, Lifts, snow School, groomers, & Snowmakers Interactions
- 1. Direct and continuous contact with guests.
- 2. Direct and continuous contact with co-workers, management, and other departments.
- 3. Must have the ability to interact at any time with guests and other employees in a pleasant
- manner and maintain good working relationships with others and all departments at MSLM
